Energy Bills Support Scheme

Households with no direct relationship to a domestic energy supplier - such as many care home residents, those living in park homes, and residents of caravans and houseboats on registered sites - will be able to apply for a £400 fuel bill discount under a new EBSS Alternative Funding Scheme. Online applications will open in January 2023 alongside a helpline for those without online access. Payments will be made by local authorities

£200 Alternative Fuel Payment (AFP) will be made to households in Great Britain that use alternative fuels such as biomass or heating oil, with eligible households receiving payments automatically via their electricity supplier in February 2023 or, for example if they do not have a relationship with an electricity supplier, through the same gov.uk portal that will be used to apply for support under EBSS Alternative Funding
